Build Knowledge

This programme manages **cognitive load** for staff relating to Curriculum and indoor and outdoor pedagogy by **revisiting prior learning** and deepening thinking about learning, play pedagogy and Curriculum.

Motivate Staff

Each EEd network has a sharp focus on Curriculum or Pedagogy with a clear **set goal** for implementation. Each session is routed in **evidence** and **research** and will meet the latest OfSTED and DfE guidance. **Affirmation and reinforcement** is integral to everything we do at EEd.

Develop teaching techniques

Through a combination of **instructional** coaching and **social support** via an ongoing network of **EEd** schools. Practitioners will have both an opportunity to model and **rehearse** the strategies before knowledgeable **monitoring and feedback** take place.

Embedd Practice

EEd materials support prompts and cues, while our Leaders Network encourages **monitoring and feedback** and professional conversations around **action planning** and **context specific repetitions**.


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Year 1 Programme

Following the high number of requests last year for Year 1 support, it would be valuable to establish a dedicated network for Year 1 staff. This will run throughout the year, rather than being squeezed into the summer term, giving us time to explore the issues in depth and share practices collaboratively. A successful transition from Reception into Year 1 is about so much more than a box of Lego and a book corner. When approached with care and intention, there is no lost learning time; pupils are socially and emotionally well-adjusted, and parents and carers do not experience the “shock” of Year 1. This is not about managing SEND pupils in Year 1—that is already a given. Instead, the focus is on shaping a pedagogically appropriate curriculum that supports continuity, development, and progression for all children.

Year 1 Programme

Year 1 Transition Network 2025

Three 1.5-hour online EEd network sessions designed to support Year 1 staff in creating successful, seamless transitions from Reception.

Each session will include:

- A focused Year 1 transition input from Emma, offering evidence-informed guidance and practical strategies.
- A virtual walk-around of a Year 1 classroom, showcasing layout, provision, and approaches that strengthen continuity.
- Well-crafted, accountable action steps for participants to take back and apply in their own classrooms immediately.

This network will help ensure:

- No lost learning time for pupils
- Social and emotional adjustment is embedded
- Parents and carers experience a smooth transition into Year 1
- Staff are equipped with a pedagogically appropriate curriculum that supports all learners. 3 x £50-£150
